An update on your project

The last month saw the site re-open after the Christmas break on 4th January.

The tower crane installation had been pushed back many times due to weather conditions and was finally installed in two stages on 15th and 16th January and 29th and 30th January. The tower crane will become operational Thursday 10th February.

Piling finished on 2nd February.

Thames Water will be carrying out a survey of the existing sewer on Monday 7th February.

Foundation and excavation works are ongoing.

The Minister met a number of our team who have taken an early careers' route with Kier, such as apprenticeships or the Kier degree, and spoke about the fantastic job and career opportunities Kier and the construction industry offer to local communities and young people.

This exciting project will create around:

- ✓ 10 local new job opportunities

- outreach programmes to local businesses and schools

In partnership with our supply chain this project will, at its peak, have around 250 skilled tradespeople on site and, after the two year construction period, will have created around 2000 job and work experience opportunities overall.
