AIMS FOR EDUCATION

AT MULBERRY ACADEMY LONDON DOCK

Our aim is to support the very highest aspirations of students at Mulberry Academy London Dock because we believe this enables them to lead successful, happy and fulfilled lives, making a contribution to their own community and to wider British society.

Every student will receive an education that has three key aims:

1 To engender high levels of academic ambition with knowledge of how to learn and how to communicate one's learning and strong understanding through high quality, confident writing and speaking. Students will learn the intellectual skills and technical language for the subjects they study so that they can perform at the highest level. Students will be taught how to be independent learners and how to work together to support each other in successful learning.

2 To provide rich personal development that includes a strong moral, spiritual and social foundation, to foster a highly developed imagination and creativity. Students will be taught to think critically and analytically, to be curious and question, and to be open-minded with a strong understanding of the world around them. Students will be supported to develop confidence, resilience and security in their abilities and to extend their talents. Students will be helped to develop their 'voice' and will be provided with a variety of platforms through which they can practise public speaking and make their voices heard.

3 To enable the development of high aspirations and self-determination through opportunities for leadership, engagement with higher education and the professional workplace and experience of different cultures. Students will become global ambassadors – for the school, their community and for British society. Students will actively work for positive social change.



At Mulberry Academy London Dock, we believe in making connections and fostering relationships with external partners in higher education, business, industry, the arts and the sciences. These external partners include Mercedes-Benz Grand Prix Ltd who support our STEM work, the National Theatre who support the arts and Barts Health NHS trust. Our partners enrich the curriculum and provide opportunities for learning outside the classroom, including employer led projects and partnerships. Our enrichment offer at Mulberry Academy London Dock is extensive and includes:

- » **Greenpower** – opportunity to design, build and race a green powered car.
- » **Performance** – regular opportunities to participate in the arts, drama and music. For example students performing at the Edinburgh Festival Fringe.
- » **Subject societies** – regular lectures, speakers and visits to our top universities and institutions.
- » **International trips** – to help develop an appreciation and understanding of the world.
- » **Sports coaching** – in particular cricket, football, rugby, martial arts, hockey, fencing, rowing and climbing.
- » **Outdoor education** – to encourage experiential learning and improved mental health and wellbeing.

IMAGINATION, INNOVATION,

At Mulberry Academy London Dock we provide the highest quality of teaching supported by excellent pastoral care and support for learning. Our curriculum is academically rigorous, but differentiated to support all students.

Students are encouraged to develop an understanding of how they can become better learners, how emotional intelligence and personal learning and thinking skills can help them progress, as well as their responsibility as community members and successful citizens.

We will ensure your child is well cared for and supported through:

A team of tutors and pastoral leaders who work with your child throughout their educational journey and take responsibility for students' personal development and wellbeing.

A team of staff in the inclusion team will ensure each young person's needs are met through in class support and additional intervention for those who need this.

Curriculum subjects

The curriculum is a rich, academic curriculum for 11-18 year olds providing a seven-year learning journey with these features:

- » **A strong, successful emphasis on basic skills in literacy, numeracy and ICT.**
- » **A rigorous and unashamedly ambitious approach to academic learning.**
- » **Inclusive and adaptive to stretch and challenge all learners.**
- » **A flourishing, vibrant arts and science education.**
- » **An extensive extra-curricular programme.**
- » **Opportunities for performance, self-expression and public speaking.**
- » **Global citizenship and political literacy.**
- » **Growth in leadership skills and understanding.**

Students at Key Stage 3 will follow the full National Curriculum including English, Maths, Science, Religious Education, History, Geography, Modern Foreign Language, Computer Science, Physical Education, Art, Music, Drama and Technology.

Students at GCSE will study English, Maths, Science, Religious Education, PSHE, PE and will choose a Modern Foreign Language, a Humanities subject and an Arts/Design subject. Students will be able to study Triple Sciences and Computer Science at GCSE.

Mulberry Academy London Dock's innovative design uses Passivhaus technologies, bringing fresh, filtered air and reduced pollution levels resulting in a better supportive environment for learning.

Our school will be a civic building of which the community will be proud. It has been designed by architects to support high quality learning alongside high quality recreation areas, excellent light levels and superb acoustics.

The building features:

- » Modern classrooms with large interactive teaching screens.
- » Specialist science and technology spaces.
- » Performance spaces that allow for intimate or large performances, equipped with integrated audio and lighting.
- » Extensive facilities for a variety of sports and leisure which will be open for community use.

All of our buildings and changing rooms are wheelchair accessible, with disabled toilets and lifts, allowing access to all floors.
